Ready Set Read Sarasota

This committee was charged with developing the framework for a literacy project that the Siesta Key Kiwanis Club can embrace and support. This is our initial proposal for that project.

Background: Research shows that for children to succeed in school, it is crucial that they are reading ready when they enter kindergarten or first grade.

- Nearly half of all children under 6 in Sarasota and DeSoto Counties live in poverty.
- Children who live in poverty are less ready to read for a number of reasons, including less access to books, and less access to the vocabulary and discussions books bring.
- 46% of children in Sarasota and surrounding counties are not ready to read when they enter school

Project objectives: Collaborating with other organizations in order to work effectively and efficiently, we will work to get books to the children who need them most, children from 0-5 years old, living in poverty in Sarasota and DeSoto counties.

Planned actions: We will:

- Identify the appropriate children and programs with help from Early Learning Coalitions and other groups.
- Provide age and language-appropriate books for their preschool classrooms, day care facilities and homes, as is appropriate.
- Provide reading extension materials to engage teachers, parents, care givers, and families in the learning process, both with the book as it is delivered, and afterwards with a dedicated website.
- Apply for grants that provide books or funds to purchase affordable books
- Encourage Kiwanis club members and SLP members to engage in the project raising funds, collecting books, reading to children, and participating in book distributions.
- Evaluate success by tracking the number of books we distribute, to whom they are distributed, whether they are for classroom use or for children to enjoy at home.

How it's different: This program differs from some traditional programs in several powerful ways, including:

- the valuable extension materials and website that will engage multiple contacts and generations in the learning process
- evaluation that will provide feedback to our club, our funders and our client groups on the program's progress, enabling us to make focused improvements.

We ask the Board to adopt "Ready Set Read Sarasota" as a project of the Siesta Key Kiwanis Club and Foundation.
